Eligibility Requirements and Instructions

- ✓ You are eligible to apply for the Family Education Program if you are a Unifor member in good standing and have a spouse/partner and/or children 18 years of age or younger (if you do not have a spouse/partner and/or children 18 years of age or younger to attend with you, you are not eligible. (You do not require Paid Education Leave [PEL] in your contract.)
- ✓ You are **NOT eligible** to apply for the Family Education Program if you have attended within the last 10 years.
- ✓ Unifor will provide, free of charge, food and lodging to each participant and immediate family (spouse/partner and dependent children (up to and including age 18 only)) during your stay at the Education Centre.
- ✓ Each participant must contribute their time (vacation, personal leave, etc.). **NO LOST TIME, PER DIEM, OR MILAGE WILL BE PAID.**
- ✓ **Please fill out the entire application form**, including date and signatures. Have it signed by your local union President or Financial Secretary and return all 3 pages of application **by Friday, April 17, 2020 to:**
